

I believe this is the 6<sup>th</sup> year since we have been blessed with a nesting pair of American Bald Eagles on our course. In case you don't know where they are located, they are about 100 yards from #14 green on the left side of the fairway. We were afraid that after Hurricane Matthew and the amount of trees that were damaged that they might not come back this year. Please enjoy looking at them but also please do not disturb. We want them to come back every year. One thing we must talk about this month and needs to be addressed is the use of 'Handicap' flags and the rules concerning their use. There has always been a fine line of when and when not to give out these flags. In the past they were only given to those who could produce a 'note' from their Doctor. Only thing was that that was not fair to those individuals who might be suffering from a temporary impairment not under Doctor supervision and not permanent. I, being the Director of Golf here at Goldsboro Municipal Golf Course, want everyone to be able and participate in this great game. Most people abide by our very simple 'Handicap' rules, but there are always those that abuse it. The biggest rule concerning this is keeping the carts 20 feet from all tees and greens. This is a very important rule in that the area of the golf course most susceptible to damage are in these areas, especially around the greens. In 2017, this WILL be more greatly enforced. You will be warned 3 times if noticed. On the fourth time, we will have a conversation. This is your course, please take care of it. 'Slow Play' is and has always been a major headache for every golf course. The only thing we ask here at Goldsboro Municipal is that you keep up with the group in front of you. It should never take, even at our busiest times, more than 4 hours to play a round of golf. If you happen to be playing on one of our unusual slow days and if a group catches up to you and there is a hole open in front, by all means, please let them through. As in everything else in life, if you just go by the "Golden Rule" (Do unto others as you would have them do unto you) the world would be a much better place. The Golf Course Committee will be meeting January 25<sup>th</sup> at 11:00am here at the course. This meeting is open to all and you are invited to attend. Concerns can be stated to any committee member. They are: Mike Farfour, Byron Ash, Ricky Farfour, Gene Farmer, Doug Safford, Milas Kelly and Joe Thomas. One thing that was brought up and will be discussed at the next meeting was proposed by Milas Kelly and is the possibility of having a 'Memorial' area with the use of brick pavers with the inscription of names either in 'Honor' or 'Memory' of some individual or group. I personally think this would be a great idea. Inscribed pavers would probably be sold at \$50.00 each. Keep that in mind if you might want to participate in purchasing one or more. Also we have a locker room dedicated for the storing of golf clubs now. It is only \$60.00 per year, due July 1. If you rent one now it would only be \$30.00 until July 1. Check with Pro Sop to reserve yours now.

- Tee times required for weekend and holiday play and can be made one week in advance
- Members and guests must have a valid drivers license to operate golf cars
- Practice proper golf etiquette
- Return golf cars by the posted time
- No private coolers allowed—No Glass Bottles
- No Refunds
