
## Greetings Fellow Golfers,

Please pardon the above sketch, but what I want to try and impress is cart routing (flow pattern) that we want to achieve here at the new Event Center. When we first moved in 1 July, the only water available to wash carts was located at the Pro Shop. We have since then installed water where it is needed which is at the far South end of the cart barn. Please try and return your carts to this area. Also notice that after you play your round and are coming back to the clubhouse, continue going straight past the South end of the cart barn to the parking lot, unload your clubs and come back to the Cart Return area by coming by the North side of the cart barn. If you are keeping your clubs in the club storage area, continue on the same routing except come around the building as you were going to the parking lot, park at the bag storage area and unload your clubs. Speaking of bag storage area. Byron Ash graciously donated his time and talents to assembling the storage units. From all the members and staff, THANKS!!! Look for some time this month to start renting out these spaces. Price will only be \$60.00 per year. If you wish to keep your pull cart in there also there will be an additional charge of \$24.00 per year. I'll shoot out a mass email when we are ready. Don't forget locker room storage of the small lockers of \$24.00 per year. Those spots are available now. When Tennis and Pickle Ball start up, these lockers will go quick. This month on the 8<sup>th</sup> we will be hosting the TYGA (Tarheel Youth Golf Association) for a one day event. They will tee off that day at 8:00 am and be finished by 12:00. Course will be closed that morning. These young adults will be coming from North and South Carolina and Virginia. A lot of very good junior talent will be playing. Beginner Golf Camp will be held here July 14-15 from 9 till 12:00. This camp is designed for of course the beginner golfer ages 5-16 years. Fee is \$40.00. This fee also included Tennis on Monday thru Wednesday. Check with Parks and Recreation to sign up. Wayne County Men's Amateur Golf Championship which will be held July 15-17 still has some available spots. Entries have been extended until July 6. See any participating course for applications (Goldsboro Municipal, Lane Tree, Southern Wayne or Walnut Creek). We are now into the peak growing season. With that in mind, the Driving Range must be maintained. You can just about count on that every Thursday we will have to mow the Range.
