As you can see from the above picture left, High School Golf Season has officially kicked off. We have 4 teams that call Goldsboro Municipal home. They are Wayne Country Day, Eastern Wayne, Goldsboro High and Rosewood. Great bunch of young adults with their coaches. Their practice days are Monday-Thursday from 3:30 to closing utilizing the Driving Range and the course. Etiquette is always a priority with the coaches and team members. While they will be utilizing play on the course, every student knows that members and paying guests have priority. If at any time, proper golf etiquette is not being used, please notify Pro Shop Staff. It is our and the coach's responsibility to guide these young adults on the correct adult behavior while playing our course. Also please notice on the calendar dates of High School Matches. On these dates we will try to the best of our ability to minimize members and paying players discomfort. Starting after Daylight Savings Time, 18 hole matches start at 2:00pm and last till closing. All starts utilize a 'Shotgun' start on the front nine with the front closing an hour and a half before that time. If you tee off by 12:30 on these days, you will be able to play an interrupted round of golf. Goldsboro Municipal Golf Course does not close on High School Tournament days. Also please notice that by recommendation of the Golf Course Committee, a 'Porta-John' has been located at the old picnic shelter to the right of hole number 9. The Committee also saw a need for a golf cart to be left at hole number 10 for walkers to utilize that need to come to the Pro Shop after 9 holes, either for rest room or beverages. Please use this cart that will be in place every weekend, but do put it back where you found it. Also during this summer, we will be using a dual use of the on-course Ranger. Not only will he/she be enforcing course rules, but there will be a limited amount of supplies (drinks and snacks) on the cart for resale. Please don't abuse this service by making them run back off the course to the Pro Shop for special items. Also mentioned in the February Newsletter, I will be conducting a 'Free' clinic on the 2nd and 4th Saturday of each month from 10:00 till 11:00. No sign-up necessary, just show up on the Driving Range. Until then, enjoy this Spring-like weather!!!
