There have been situations of cars driving onto the course, not to mention neighborhood children riding bicycles and other wheeled objects down the hills. Vandalism is always a possibility. In the original plan on moving to our new location, the large parking lot was to be removed leaving only the one in front of the old clubhouse intact making it use for overflow parking only. Intent of the City of Goldsboro was for all patrons that are playing golf to park in the Event Center parking lot and check in with the Pro Shop before beginning play.

We are now starting to get a number of people, mostly members, park in this old lot and going out to play. Please respect the City's wishes. This is mainly for your safety. If someone parks in the wrong location, and does not check in, if a family emergency happens and we get that dreaded call to ask if you are playing golf, we have no record of you having checked in (everyone that checks in is entered into the POS system along with the time). There have also been a couple of times where someone parked in this old lot and snuck onto the course without paying the appropriate fees. Just a reminder on range balls. If you have purchased the \$50.00 card for 15 large buckets of balls, feel free to share with whomever you want. If you either paid your dues Annually or Yearly, range balls are included with your membership. But remember, they can only be used by you or your family member. Family member by definition is you, your spouse and dependent children. One last thing and I will quit. This concerns golf carts. Main purpose of our carts is for personal transportation during playing a round of golf only. Unfortunately, that our move to our new location has created a great distance from Pro Shop to Driving Range. We have, as a courtesy, allowed patrons to borrow a cart to go and hit their purchased balls on the range only. After range use it is expected for carts to be immediately returned to the Pro Shop (only exception to this are for coaches of high school or college teams, having paid appropriate fees). Hopefully this small problem will be solved when our new fleet of cars arrives. I have negotiated the use of 2 extra carts with rear seating with no additional charged that will be used for shuttle service from Pro Shop to Driving Range and back and general tournament use. Don't forget our annual Easter Egg Hunt this Easter Sunday. On each of the 18 holes an Easter Egg will be tenderly hidden (most all in full view). Inside each egg is a number redeemable in the Pro Shop. Please remember <u>only one egg per customer</u>. Also the Wayne County Senior Games are scheduled for the 9 & 10th. Tee off is 1:00am both days with Women playing Monday and Men playing Tuesday. Course will NOT be closed but if you wish to use a reciprocal, please do. We will do everything in our power to get people wanting to play on the Jody F. Dean, PGA course
