Hybrid club donated by USA Mobile Golf Sales, dozen Srixon balls by Pro Shop staff. Thanks to all that helped. 'Buy a Brick' campaign is still in progress. Hopefully mason will be here in December to start laying bricks by flagpole. Cost is only \$50 per brick to be paid in Pro Shop. First order will be January 1, 2018. This would make a great Christmas gift to perpetually honor or memorialize someone you know or love. On December 20 we will be having a Golf Course Committee meeting, 2:00 in the Dining Room at the course. Just as in the City Council meetings, this is a great time to voice your concerns and/or comments concerning our golf course. During the entire month of December, Goldsboro Municipal Golf Course will be having a 'Canned Food Drive'. We will be accepting no-perishable canned food items that will be donated to the 'Make a Difference Food Pantry'. Speaking of the 'Make a Difference Food Pantry', on December 16 (Saturday) we will be having a 2-person 'Triple Six' Golf Tournament, 10:00 Shotgun start. Entry fee into this tournament is by either donating 10 cans of non-perishable food or a minimum \$10.00 donation to the 'Make a Difference Food Pantry' and if a member of our course, a \$13.00 cart fee. Non-members can play for the same as above but will need to pay a \$25.00 cart and green fee. For those that don't know what a Triple Six Tournament is, hole 1-6 is 2 person Best-Ball, 7-12 Modified Alternate Shot, 13-18 Superball. This will a Gross & Net tournament using established USGA and Committee designated handicaps if you don't have one. \$10 per team 'Net' Skin Tournament will also be included. It does get to be rather confusing to some, but trust me, just find a partner and come out on December 16 and have a great time for a worthy cause. Let the Committee worry about the scoring. For those into deep reading, a simplified list of Rules is included with this Newsletter and full list in the Pro Shop. Hole #13 is looking good with the newly placed sod. We are still asking patrons to please keep carts on path this hole until the sod can firmly establish itself. If your ball lands within the sod, please be advised it is being played as 'Ground Under Repair', which means you can play your ball from where it lies or take total relief no closer to the hole. If you do play it from there, please like elsewhere on the course, repair your divot. Also the management wants avoid waste as much as possible, so please when you play and ride a cart, have your friend ride with you. We are starting to get too many people wanting to ride by themselves. 4 golfers with 4 carts is not eco-friendly.
